Minutes Arts & Culture Committee Meeting

Tuesday, November 10, 2020, 7:00 pm
Via Zoom

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I. Welcome and Introductions

- A. The meeting was called to order at 7:11 pm.
- B. Welcome and introductions. There were 7 attendees at the meeting. Committee members present were Jillian Schultz, James Bennett, Carlos Delgado, Louise Reichlin, and Lynn Fountain Campbell. Other attendees were Kevin A, and Kazue Chinen. Lynn read the mission statement of the Arts & Culture committee, to refresh our purpose.
- C. 1. Jillian commented on the upcoming joint conversation between EHNC, LFNC, and SLNC, the subject of which is "endangered spaces / queer venues." Kaz will get the Spanish event blurb and send out the official email. James Bennett will run the tech for the event.
2. Louise announced the virtual San Pedro Arts Festival will be re-streamed from November 26th through December 6th. And a new production of Urban and Tribal Dances will be aired from December 15th through the end of the year. She also needs to be added to the distribution list for the EHNC newsletter, so she can forward it to her contacts.

D. The minutes of the October meeting were read. Jillian moved to approve, James seconded. One typo was corrected, and the minutes of the October meeting were unanimously approved as read.

II. Action Items

A. Regarding the utility box art program, this item was tabled until the next meeting, since Vivian was not able to attend the meeting tonight.

B. Regarding the letter of support for the Fountain Theatre outdoor stage, James presented the artist renderings for the project. They plan to clear out the parking lot and place the stage toward the back of the lot and would like to have it completed by Spring/Summer 2021. They have good working relationships with all the neighbors, so the project will go smoothly. The artist renderings showed socially distanced seating, and they are conducting sound studies, to conform to City and County regulations regarding the number of decibels allowed. The project is good for the neighborhood and employs a number of people here. Jillian will put it before the board at the next EHNC meeting on November 16th, and she and Nina can sign a letter that will be drafted by James and Jillian.

C. Regarding the proposed NPG for Barnsdall Arts Sundays, this item was tabled, since Shelah was not able to attend.

D. Regarding a virtual Virgil Village First Fridays event, Lynn gave an update. She and Vivian met via a Zoom call on October 22nd. Vivian has been made an Admin on the Virgil Village First Fridays Facebook page, and has also been given the VVFF email list. She drafted an email to be sent to the list, so Lynn sent it to the list, introducing her to them. We may be able to have a soft reopening in December, to try to take advantage of holiday shopping, but our big relaunch will probably take place in January. We have had one response to the email from one business interested in more information. Our next step is to formulate a response to send to interested businesses, and Lynn will contact Vivian to see about getting this done.
