EAST HOLLYWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL *Minutes Arts & Culture Committee Meeting* Tuesday, January 12, 2021, 7:00 pm Via Zoom

Public comments on agenda items will be heard when the item is considered. Public comments on other matters within the council's jurisdiction may be made during the Public Comment period. Public comments are limited to two minutes per speaker. Action may be taken on any agenda item except Public Comment, announcements and reports. Actions may be reconsidered only if a motion for reconsideration is adopted at the same meeting where the action was taken. You may request a copy of printed materials that are distributed at the meeting. You may record the meeting by audio, video or photographic means as long as it is not disruptive. Meeting notices and agendas are posted at various locations (see list below). If you need translation, or accommodation for a disability, please call the city Department of Neighborhood Empowerment at least three business days in advance (213- 485-1360, or toll-free 3-1-1). The city is a covered entity under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you believe the council is not following the law or its own rules you may file a grievance in writing with copies to both the Chair and the Secretary. Please be respectful of others, even when you differ with them.

I. Welcome and Introductions

- A. The meeting was called to order at 7:11 pm by Jillian Schultz, since Lynn's internet connection was unstable.
- B. Welcome and introductions. There were 7 attendees at the meeting. Committee members present were Jillian Schultz, James Bennett, Louise Reichlin, Lucine Porturyan, and Lynn Fountain Campbell. Shelah Lehrer-Graiwer was also present.
- C. There were no public comments.
- D. The minutes of the November meeting were read. Jillian moved to approve, James seconded, and the minutes of the November meeting were unanimously approved as read.

II. Action Items

- A. Regarding the utility box art program, since the produce box giveaway seemed more necessary to the needs of the neighborhood at this time, we discussed donating the funds that have been earmarked for the art program to the produce box giveaway, so that program can continue. Jillian moved and James seconded

the motion, and the motion was unanimously approved. The utility box art program will be revisited in the new fiscal year.

B. Regarding the proposed NPG for Barnsdall Arts Sundays, Shelah Lehrer-Graiwer presented her request, with the schedules that have been published online, showing the EHNC logo to acknowledge our support of the event. When the lockdown happened, they immediately pivoted to an online event and have been Zooming since April. The theme of the event is World Culture, and they have been teaching via Zoom about arts from many nations. They have a dedicated following, and Barnsdall Arts is the only program still functioning since the lockdown. The next step is for them to gather their NPG materials from the EHNC website and do a formal presentation before the Budget & Finance committee at their next meeting.

C. Regarding a virtual Virgil Village First Fridays event, Vivian gave an update. With only one or two interested respondents, we agreed we should table the event until we're in a position to do more in person promotion of it (after covid).

There was no old or new business.
