EAST HOLLYWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL *Minutes Arts & Culture Committee Meeting* Tuesday, February 9, 2021, 7:00 pm Via Zoom

Public comments on agenda items will be heard when the item is considered. Public comments on other matters within the council's jurisdiction may be made during the Public Comment period. Public comments are limited to two minutes per speaker. Action may be taken on any agenda item except Public Comment, announcements and reports. Actions may be reconsidered only if a motion for reconsideration is adopted at the same meeting where the action was taken. You may request a copy of printed materials that are distributed at the meeting. You may record the meeting by audio, video or photographic means as long as it is not disruptive. Meeting notices and agendas are posted at various locations (see list below). I. Welcome and Introductions

- A. The meeting was called to order at 7:08 pm by Lynn Fountain Campbell.
- B. Welcome and introductions. There were 5 attendees at the meeting. Committee members present were Jillian Schultz, James Bennett, Carlos Delgado, Skylar Summers, and Lynn Fountain Campbell. Alexandra, a member of the public, was also present.
- C. There were no public comments.
- D. The minutes of the January meeting were unavailable, so Jillian gave a recap of what occurred at the meeting.

II. Action Items

- A. Regarding the ongoing Small Revolutions series collaboration with LFNC and SLNC, the subject of the next conversation is youth homelessness and the impact of covid on our unhoused neighbors. In April the subject will be life along the L.A. River. James will be taking over from Jillian for March, since Jillian will be

involved in Community Day until February 24th. These joint conversations have been proving fruitful, are gaining momentum, and getting positive feedback from the community.

III. Old/New Business

A. Jillian reminded us that Skylar will be chairing the first meeting of the LGBTQ committee, and suggested that it would be a good idea to show that the neighborhood welcomes members of the LGBTQ community. Skylar has been in conversations with George at CD13, regarding opportunities to collaborate. Since we won't be having Pride Day this year, she suggested we commemorate it in some way, such as with rainbow crosswalks, as they do in Venice.

B. Jillian also reported that Jimmy of Jimbo Times and Samantha want a conversation about gentrification, redlining, and minority-owned businesses specific to East Hollywood. James will be taking over Jillian's duties for March and will also be handling tech support, since the event will be broadcast on our Zoom channel.

C. Under old business, Carlos would like to be included on the email list for the Small Revolutions events.

IV. Adjournment – The meeting was adjourned at 7:31 pm.
