## EAST HOLLYWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL *Minutes Arts & Culture Committee Meeting* Tuesday, March 9, 2021, 7:00 pm Via Zoom

Public comments on agenda items will be heard when the item is considered. Public comments on other matters within the council's jurisdiction may be made during the Public Comment period. Public comments are limited to two minutes per speaker. Action may be taken on any agenda item except Public Comment, announcements and reports. Actions may be reconsidered only if a motion for reconsideration is adopted at the same meeting where the action was taken. You may request a copy of printed materials that are distributed at the meeting. You may record the meeting by audio, video or photographic means as long as it is not disruptive. Meeting notices and agendas are posted at various locations (see list below). If you need translation, or accommodation for a disability, please call the city Department of Neighborhood Empowerment at least three business days in advance (213- 485-1360, or toll-free 3-1-1). The city is a covered entity under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. ### I. Welcome and Introductions

- A. The meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm by Lynn Fountain Campbell.
- B. Welcome and introductions. There were 7 attendees at the meeting. Committee members present were Jillian Schultz, Louise Reichlin, James Bennett, Carlos Delgado, Skylar Summers, and Lynn Fountain Campbell. Jeff Mahoney, a member of the LGBTQ committee, was also present.
- C. There were no public comments.
- D. The minutes of the January meeting were read, and a typo was corrected. James moved to approve and Jillian seconded, and the minutes of the January meeting were unanimously approved as corrected.
- E. The minutes of the February meeting were read. Jillian made a correction to the subject of the joint discussions between EHNC, LFNC, and SLNC. Jillian moved to approve, James seconded, and the minutes of the February meeting were unanimously approved as corrected.

### II. Action Items

**A.** Regarding the ongoing Small Revolutions series collaboration with LFNC and SLNC, the subject of the next conversation Life along the L.A. River and will cover the L.A. River Master Plan, the history of the area, and stories of current lives of unhoused residents there. So three viewpoints will be aired: that of the government (Master Plan), that of the indigenous people, and that of the current residents. The event will be live and later edited into a podcast for re-broadcast. Jillian will make a presentation to the EHNC board at its next meeting, with an eye toward earmarking funds to promote the event more broadly.

**B.** Regarding the land acknowledgement, honoring native land, we want to do research and outreach to trace the ethnic history of East Hollywood. Resources would include Jimmy and Samantha from the joint discussions that have been ongoing. We can also reach out to Native American groups through their websites, and also to academic institutions such as UCLA, USC, and LACC. Carlos and Jillian will participate in this aspect, with the intention of looking for the best approach and expressing a desire for broader engagement with more diverse participation.
